Beausoleil First Nation in partnership with the Nookmis Revenue Fund is seeking to fill two (2) positions for a **Forestry Crew Member** as part of the 2021-2022 Nookiidaa project.

Qualifications:

- Some knowledge of silviculture and proper forestry management practices
- Must have effective interpersonal skill to be able to communicate, understand and respond to questions, instructions, signs, signals, and safety training
- Ability to work independently and within a team environment
- CSA approved safety boots
- G2 or G Ontario driver's licence would be an asset
- Ability to work independently and to follow and carry out instructions
- Physically able to carry out functions of the job
- Ability to work under the BFN Administration Policies and Procedures

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Follow instructions and direction from supervisors for proper forestry management practices and procedures
- The Forestry Crew Worker(s) will be responsible for cutting, splitting, and delivery of fuel wood to the disabled and elders
- Ability to safely operate relevant equipment for extended durations (chain saw, axe/mulls, wedges)
- Ability to operate heavy equipment (tractor, truck, winches) would be an asset but not required.
- Physically able to work in all-weather elements and on uneven terrain
- Acquired knowledge of Forest health and safety issues and worksite safety practices
- Acquired knowledge of equipment (maintenance of chain saws, axes/mulls/wedges)
- Acquired knowledge and licences to operate heavy equipment (tractor, truck, winches)
- Ensure personal protective equipment (PPE) is always worn and observe safe work practices
- Maintain an excellent attendance record, an excellent safety record, and work quality record
- Must be able to perform repetitive/physical tasks for extended periods of time and lift items of up to 50 lbs
- Perform other duties, as assigned
