- All teams must be affiliated (whether Aboriginal or non-Aboriginal organization/agencies) with Ogemawahj Tribal Council and its Member Nations.

### Individual and Team Recognition & Awards:

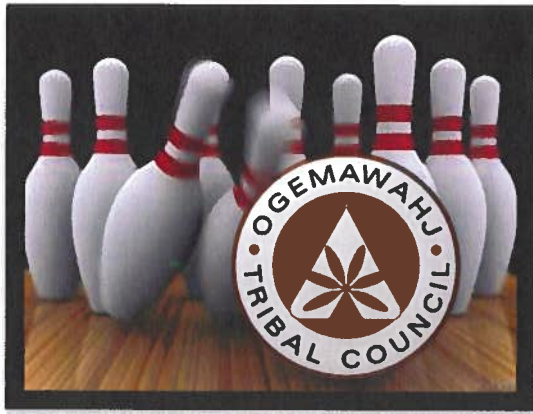
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams
- High single and triple for men and women
- Lowest single and triple for men and women
- Best team outfits
- Best team name

### Tournament Location and Activities:

- Tournament Location – Orillia Bowl (285 Memorial Ave., Orillia, Ontario)
- Each team will play three complete games
- Teams are expected to be at tournament location no later than 12:30 pm
- Dinner and presentations will commence at 5:30 pm

### Registration:

- Team registration form must be completed and sent to OTC.
- \$300 per team (this includes shoe rental and dinner). Make check or money orders payable to Ogemawahj Tribal Council.
