### **JOB PURPOSE/SUMMARY**

Installs, maintains, and repairs industrial and residential electrical equipment and associated electrical and electronic controls for all buildings, facilities and properties operated by the Chippewas of Rama First Nation.

### **KEY JOB FUNCTIONS/RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Read and interpret drawings and electrical codes to determine electrical equipment.
- Install, examine, replace or repair electrical wiring, receptacles, switch boxes, conduits, feeders, cable assemblies, lighting fixtures, heating & cooling systems, communication equipment, signaling devices and other electrical components.
- Test electrical and electronic equipment and components for continuity, current, voltage and resistance.
- Maintain, repair, install and test switchgear, transformers, regulators etc.
- Maintain, repair, test and install electrical motors, generators, batteries and hydraulic and pneumatic electrical control systems.
- Trouble shoot, maintain and repair electrical and electronic control systems and devices.
- Conduct Preventive Maintenance programs and keep maintenance records.
- Requisition required equipment and supplies as required.
- Update as built drawings, schematic diagrams and shop drawings as required.
- Provide cost estimates as required.
- Install, test, and maintain communication and data lines (phone/computer).
- Complete all required documentation as per Rama First Nation Policies and Procedures.
- Prioritize and complete all work order requests completely in a timely manner.
