Position Title: **Facilities & Operations Maintenance - Housing Internship for Indigenous Youth (1 Positions)**

Purpose: The purpose of this position is to obtain on the job experience/skills in the area of general housing maintenance and repairs

Reports To: Facilities & Operations Manager

Qualifications: **Must be an Indigenous youth between the ages of 15 and 30**

Must not be otherwise employed during the internship.

Must not be receiving Employment Insurance benefits or must agree to discontinue the benefits before the start of the internship.

Must have Valid Class G2/G Driver's License

Must possess good interpersonal skills/team player, be punctual and have reliable transportation and physically able to perform all job duties

Must be willing to participate in any and all training deemed necessary

Responsibilities: General labour/maintenance work  
Moving office furniture  
Painting  
Minor aspects of carpentry repairs including foundations, doors, windows, floors, interior finishes, millwork, roofs, exterior finishes, insulation and related hardware.
