Contract Position: Summer Reach Ahead Credit Teacher

SUMMARY

The Reach Ahead Teacher will provide curriculum content and work collaboratively with AES partners to deliver a high school credit for Grade 8 students, who are entering Grade 9 in the fall. The course offering is HFN10 – Food and Nutrition, with emphasis on Indigenous Food Sovereignty as the overall theme of the course. The successful candidate will deliver an on-line virtual course to meet the needs of students from Regional Education Council #1 of the Anishinabek Education System.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan daily lessons to support the learners with culturally relevant pedagogy reflective of local perspectives where possible.
- Engage with knowledge keepers, Elders, and knowledgeable community members who can support understanding of Indigenous food systems and sovereignty.
- Support students with their learning and engage in conversations to provide consistent feedback as students progress in the course.
- Assess student progress.
- Ability to support learners with a virtual platform and include engaging, interactive, learning opportunities throughout the course.
- Reports to the school Principal of Pic River Private High School (Biigtigong Nishnaabeg).

THE REQUIREMENTS

- Valid Ontario College of Teachers' Certificate of Qualification.
- Experience using virtual teaching tools and platforms.
- Awareness and appreciation of First Nations Culture.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- AQ course in First Nation, Metis and Inuit studies is an asset.

HOURS OF WORK

Course offered from July 5 to 30 with five hours of engagement with students. Minimum of 1.25 hours of synchronous learning per day, with remaining hours asynchronous.

LOCATION

This is a remote position intended to support a virtual course. The successful applicant will work from his/her remote office. Reliable internet access is required.
