1. 4-Year Program:

a) Marine Engineering

Marine engineers have the awesome responsibility of operating, monitoring, and maintaining a ship's engines, electrical systems, and machinery to ensure the comfort and safety of every soul on board a vessel.

b) Marine Navigation

Navigation Officers are responsible for the safety of the ship, crew and any other person on board the vessel. They safely navigate a vessel through confined and congested waters in all types of weather and visibility.

2. 6-Month Program

a) Marine Communications and Traffic Services

The Marine Communications and Traffic Services Officers are the eyes and ears of Canadian marine traffic. It's their duty to provide services to clients and stakeholders, such as the marine industry, navigators, recreational boaters, fishers, international government agencies, provincial governments, and other federal government departments.
